

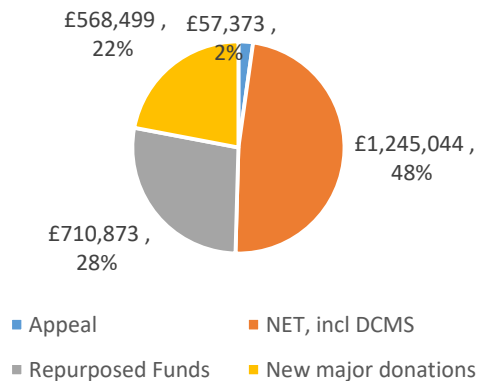

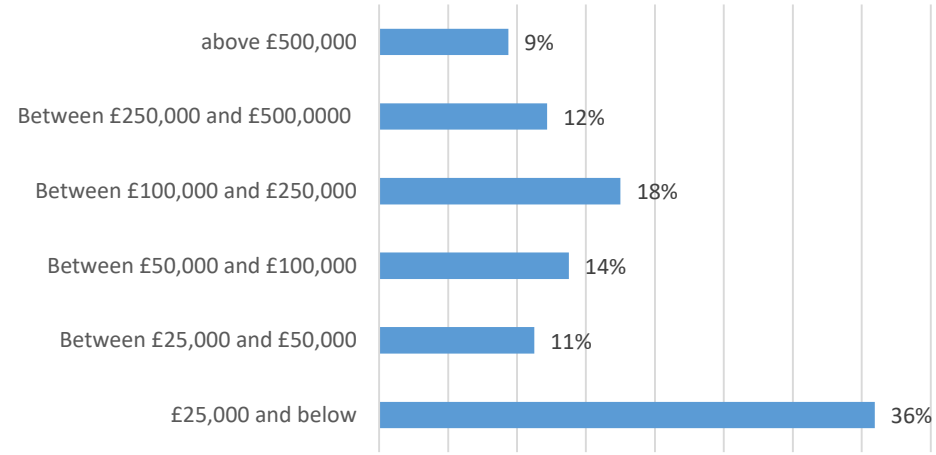
### Key data for Coronavirus Community Fund – from 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to 16<sup>th</sup> October 2020

- **£2,581,789 raised to date**
- **£1,698,724 total value of grants made**
- **Just under half of the charities supported had an annual income under £50,000 (micros charities as defined by Charity Commission)**
- **613 applications received, 584 processed and 326 awards made. 65% of awards processed were funded**

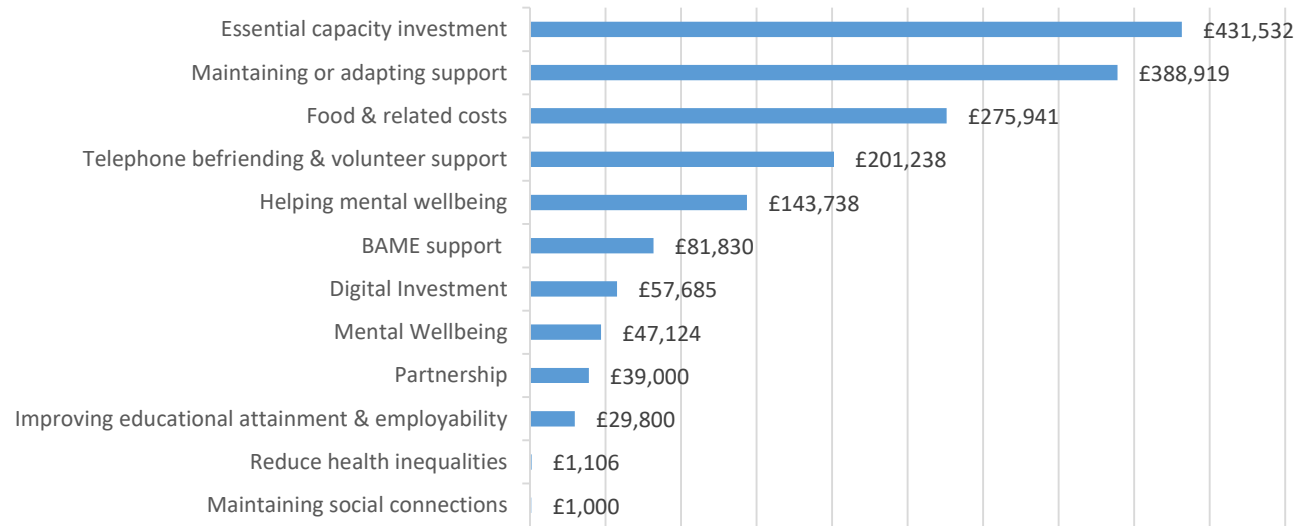
Funds raised to date March 2020 to Oct 2020



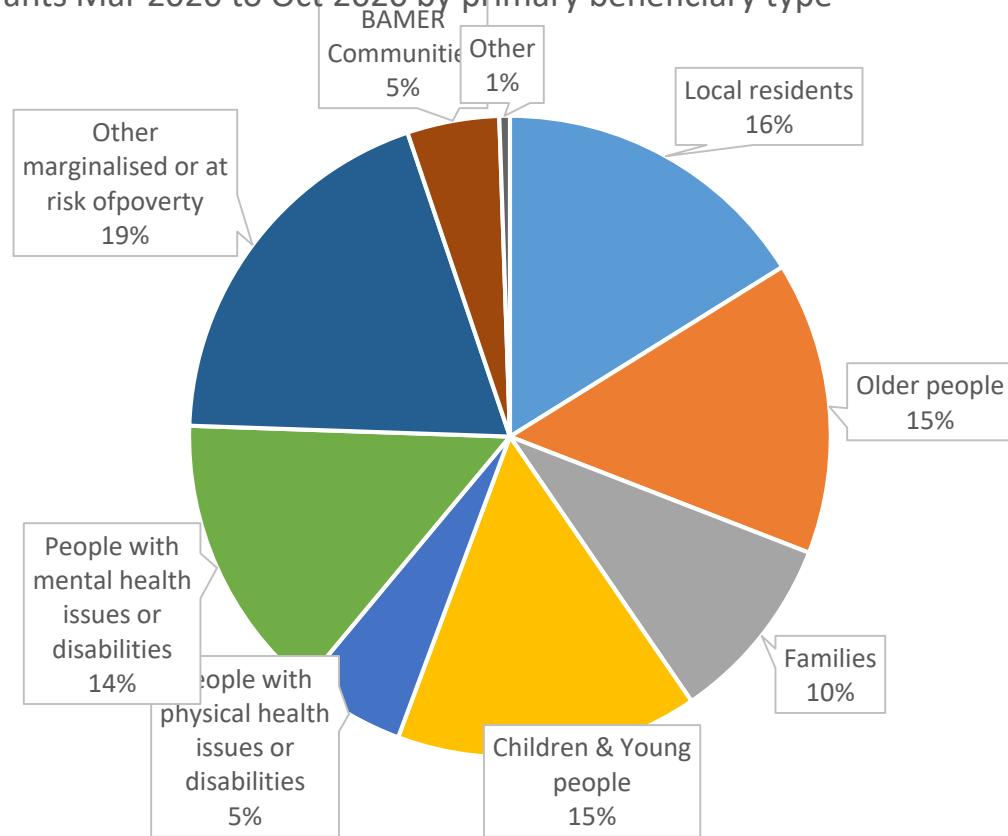
Size of charities supported by annual income



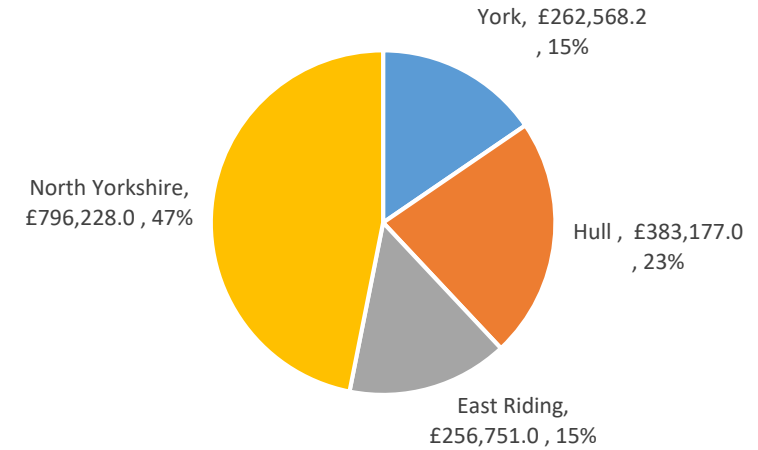
Types of support funded Mar 2020 - Octo 2020



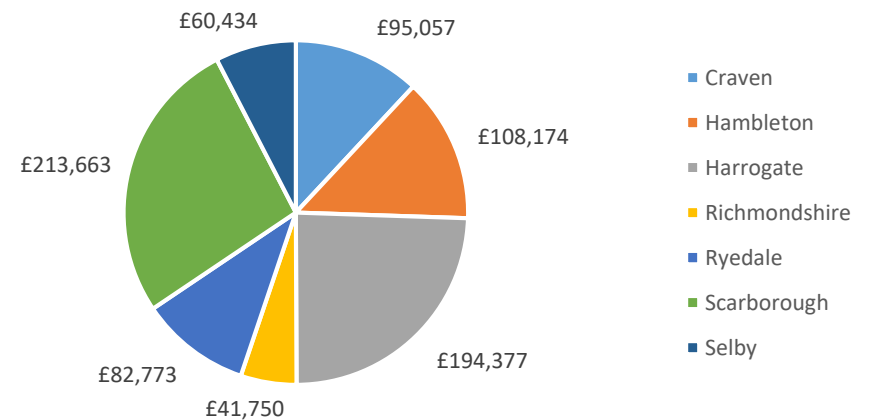
### Grants Mar 2020 to Oct 2020 by primary beneficiary type
