City of Hull Sport and Community Group CIC	05/10/2020	£8,770.00	Funding for a programme of boxing related personal development activity for young people in Goole, Cottingham and Market Weighton with the aim of improving attainment in school, improving relationships and reducing anti-social behaviour.
Market Weighton Town Council	05/10/2020	£4,600.00	Funds would be used to upgrade the existing CCTV coverage of Market Weighton's High Street area to provide better quality images to increase detection rates and help reduce the number of instances of anti-social behaviour, underage use of alcohol and the misuse of illicit drugs in the area.
Bridlington Club for Young People	05/10/2020	£18,201.00	Funding to provide fencing for the sports pitches to prevent illegal use of motorcycles which are damaging the grounds and causing a danger and a nuisance to the public.

Swinefleet Village Hall	18/12/2019	£2,500.00	Funding to provide a number of crime prevention measures at the village hall including installation of bollards to prevent vehicular access to the oil tank storage area, fencing to prevent access to private gardens from the village hall car park and CCTV for the hall, petrol station, church and surrounding area.
Bridlington Club for Young People	18/12/2019	£19,923.00	Funding to provide one-to-one support and create personal plans for young people at risk of anti-social behavior or at risk of offending; and to provide larger numbers of young people with activities at times when anti-social behavior takes place.
East Riding Voluntary Action Services	03/10/2019	£19,907.00	Grant funding to cover costs of detached youth outreach workers and a service coordinator with the aim of providing diversionary activities for young people in Beverley helping to reduce anti-social behaviour.
Driffield Youth Action	03/10/2019	£9,404.00	Funding for two Youth Workers for two years to support vulnerable young people and those who are involved in anti-social behaviours or the justice system, and to provide positive activities.
Westgate Bowling Club	03/10/2019	£1,260.00	Funding to install a five camera CCTV system. To reduce vandalism at the bowling club. Also to reduce the amount of abuse received by bowling club members and the visiting public from youth hanging around the area.
Haltemprice Skate Park Association	03/10/2019	£1,500.00	Funding to contribute to the maintenance and running of the Haltemprice skate park.
Little Weighton & District Farmwatch	03/10/2019	£10,200.00	Funding to purchase a property marking system and warning stickers, including use of a database, to improve detection rates and provide reassurance for rural communities.
Kingfisher Trust	03/10/2019	£20,000.00	Funding for running costs and maintenance of cafe providing food, other necessities and practical support to homeless and vulnerable people.

Beverley Cherry Tree community centre	28/06/2019	£6,451.00	Funding to cover the cost of a youth worker and assistant for 2 nights per week and the cost of two visits from the Hull Beats Bus. Youth activities aimed towards building social identity, self esteem and communication skills.
Hedon Town Council	28/06/2019	£955.00	Funding for CCTV to be installed to help reduce crime by acting as a deterrent and also improve detection rates.
