Hampsthwaite Memorial Hall	Funding to cover venue hire cost and dance tutor cost for the 2020 May Bank Holiday village street party event to celebrate the 75th Anniversary of V.E. Day 1945. The event is free and the 1940's Dance Party is aimed at our older residents. A 1940's style dance tutors will come to Hampsthwaite to lead a series of dance classes prior to the event.	£500
Summerbridge and Dacre Silver Band	Funding to purchase a 2nd hand baritone horn from a retired band member. The group do not have a baritone and they are expensive when new. This means anyone can get involved without the worry of a financial outlay.	£500
Hampsthwaite Wednesday Group	Funding towards Christmas dinner for 50 members.	£500
Hampsthwaite WI	Funding to cover the coach hire cost of the annual Women's Institute day trip.	£345
Hampsthwaite Feast	Funding to buy an outdoor PA system to support good information dissemination and, if necessary, provide clear emergency announcements, at public events.	£500
Fewston & Blubberhouses PCC	Funding to update heating system, kitchen, disabled access and accessible toilet.	£2500
Haverah Park with Beckwithshaw Parish Council	Funding to install traffic calming signs to reduce speeding.	£2500
Darley Memorial Hall	Funding for Kitchen equipment for catering, to aid the volunteers in catering for events, and provide good experiences for visitors. A new CCTV security system to ensure the protection of hall and contents.	£1000
Dancing for Well Being	Funding for venue costs for our weekly group and on pay for an Assistant Leader at the group. The group is aimed at age 70+.	£2500
Birstwith Horticultural Society	Funding to purchase chairs, gazebo and a refrigerator for use at the annual village show, and by local groups.	£2499
Blubberhouses Cricket Club	Funding for safety flooring to the children's play area at the cricket club, and viewing benches for parents.	£2056
Christ Church Community Centre	Funding to undertake the work needed to create safe roadside parking to accommodate overspill.	£2500
Darley Playing Field Association	Funding to install ventilation to the Sports Pavilion and shop and cafe within.	£1755
Nidderdale Plus Partnership	Funding to purchase display furniture to showcase Nidderdale themed merchandise to tourists with the remaining being used for start up stock seed money. Profits from sales to be reinvested into the charity.	£500
Hampsthwaite Gardening Club	Funding to cover the total cost of coach hire for a trip to Stillingfleet Lodge to view the gardens, followed by supper.	£390
