Applicant	Purpose of Grant	Amount Awarded
Biomation	Funding would cover the costs of a fundraising staff member and of a marketing/PR staff member. The "step change" aim is sustainability - to allow for longer term planning and the building of reserves. By making fundraising a regular activity the non-profit CIC hope to grow into a more robust and sustainable organisation. Beneficiaries are from York and the surrounding areas, young people aged up to 25 experiencing disadvantage, mental health issues and isolation.	£4,000
Leeds Baby Bank	Funding would allow Leeds Baby Bank to purchase and implement Zoho One database. The organisation supports 90 families a month. The software is a CRM system which allows them to record donations, manage staff and volunteers, manage inventory and their referral process. This would have a significant impact on the organisation enabling them to streamline their processes and speed their support up.	£4,000
Disability Support Calderdale	Funding to employ a new member of staff to support families completing a disability living allowance applications.	£4,500
Second Chance Ostomy Yorkshire	Funding to cover the rent and training of the trustees. The organisation has been recently established and is receiving support from Selby AVS. This will help strengthen the organisation.	£4,700
Musical Connections	Funding would contribute to staff costs/training needed for the group to expand their online provision. The group want to encourage new volunteers and to upskill their existing team to step change them into being more sustainable. Group aiming to improve the health and wellbeing of older, isolated and vulnerable people through musical participation.	£5,000
Peasholme Charity	Funding would contribute towards the salary of a marketing officer. (The remaining part funding has already been secured). The charity want to "step change" by developing their marketing and donor development. Peasholme Charity work with York based disadvantaged and socially excluded people, particularly those at risk of homelessness.	£5,000
KindleWoods CIC	Funding will be used to cover rent and CEOs salary for 6 months. The organisation works with people with poor wellbeing through running outdoor woodland sessions.	£1,000

Home-Start Craven	Funding would cover 3 months rent of an office within Cowling Village Hall's. Charity support families living within Craven, with at least one child under 5, who are struggling and may fail to meet the challenges of parenthood.	£1,000
TCD	Funding will enable the organisation to run fitness and wellbeing sessions for new mums. Being a new mum can be lonely, isolating and cause feelings of anxiety and inadequacy. TCD bring new mums together and offer wellbeing and exercise sessions, improving their wellbeing and increasing their support network.	£1,000
Beverley Community Lift	Funding sought to cover core costs from April 2021 onwards. Throughout the pandemic the group who support older residents in the East Riding of Yorkshire, relied upon grants to remain viable. The group have 600 registered service users. They serve deprived areas (Cherry Tree and Swinemoor estates). The group aim to promote independence and health to local elderly residents through their transport charity.	£1,000
York Neighbours	Funding will cover 2 months of overheads for the organisation. York Neighbours supports vulnerable people over the age of 65 through doing telephone calls, picking up shopping/prescriptions or doing small household tasks.	£1,000
Second Thoughts East Yorkshire	Funding to cover the rent of the office for 6 months. The organisation supports people with poor mental wellbeing.	£1,000
Bedale Community Minibus	Funding to cover the core costs of the organisation that has faced significant losses in the last financial year. The organisation provides a vital lifeline to rural communities.	£1,000
Everyday Enable	Funding to cover core costs for 12 months (office rent, insurance, phone line, printing costs). Everyday Enable CIC aim to support organisations within the Selby District in improving their disabled access and to challenge discrimination/stereotypes surrounding disability.	£1,000
Kyra Women's Project	Funding will be used to upgrade their IT equipment - this will be purchasing individual Microsoft licences and upgrading to Windows 10 Pro for staff and volunteers, with professional support. This will have a significant security impact, and an impact on improving reliability and use of time.	£3,500
Crutch	Funding for cooking project and org expansion to be able to take this on for homeless adults	£3,500

Bangladeshi Youth Organisation (BYO)	Funding will enable the organisation to increase staffing hours by 6 hours a week. This increase in staff hours will be focused on project development and fundraising, helping to sustain the organisation in to the future. There are also costs allocated towards training. The organisation plays a vital role in supporting the Bangladeshi youth community.	£5,000
York Racial Equality Network	Funding will allow the befriending sessions at Tang Hall continue and expand to twice a fortnight.	£5,000
Society for Neurodiversity (CIO) (S4Nd)	Funding for sessional staff to enable the organisation to host more online activities. S4Nd is a member run community organisation that increases the social connections and confidence in people with ND	£5,000
Incredible Edible Marshland	Funding to employ a part time co-ordinator for a year. This position will streamline the day to day, allowing the management committee time to look at develop, funding and future strategies. Incredible Edible operate in a really isolated area. They aim to connect communities through food.	£5,000
Veterans Woodcraft CIC	Funding to purchase two multi fuel stoves to heat the workshop and also to cover overheads/running costs of the Richmond based workshop for a year. The CIC aim to improve the mental health of veterans. The group ordinarily fund raise at large Yorkshire events but as these were cancelled due to Covid19 their income stream has been cut off.	£5,000
The Friendship Circle of Leeds	Funding would contribute to an expansion in the type of beneficiary this group support. Funding would contribute towards staff, training, kitchen rent, care/food packages. The group wish to hire a new sessional worker to oversee the "Smile on Seniors" project, the key goal of which is to reduce loneliness experienced the elderly in Leeds. This would allow other staff to concentrate on the special needs children.	£5,000
Peer Support - New Beginnings	Funding to employ a volunteer co-ordinator for 10 hours a week. The organisation has seen a significant increase in demand for support and having a specific member of staff to support the volunteers it will allow the organisation to streamline their support for service users.	£5,000
Settle Community and Business Hub CIC	Funding will be spent on admin/HR suport to focus on system improvement and project management. This will enable the organisation to streamline their processes and better support their community.	£5,000
Autism Angels	Funding would enable the organisation to employ a fundraiser for the next 6 months. The organisations supports people with autism and their families. The fundraiser will apply for grants and create a sustainability plan to support the organisation longer term and enable the organisation continue to develop.	£5,000

Highfield Food Coop	Funding will be used to cover overheads for 6 months and volunteer costs for the same period. The step change comes through training their volunteers.	£5,000
Platform 1	Funding to contribute to the 2021 costs of running support sessions (both group & 1:1), home outreach visits, and workshops/activities. (remaining funding needed, in addition to this grant, is already in place). This charity support men with mental health issues in West Yorkshire. Demand has risen since Covid and the charity currently work with 500+ service users.	£1,000
Moments of Light Ltd, T/A Glint	Funding to cover rent for the organisation for 3 months. The organisation has faced significant losses due to the impact of coronavirus and much of their work has been put on hold but they still have to pay for their fixed costs.	£1,000
Down Syndrome Training and Support Service Ltd	funding to cover the phone and internet costs for a year for the organisation to allow sessions to continue online. These are 0-5, youth groups, 1-to-1 support, speech and language sessions. Many of the people the organisation is supporting are self-isolating so online support is vital.	£1,000
The Hut York Ltd	Funding towards general overheads for an organisation that supports people with mental health and/or learning difficulties.	£1,000
