Experience Community CIC	Funding for staff costs and travel expenses to improve access for disabled people at several Yorkshire Water reservoirs. The project aims to support and provide opportunities for people with disabilities to have better access to the countryside.	5000
Grassroots enterprise for social inclusion and poverty relief- GESIPR	Funding for trustee, staff and volunteer development and utilities to increase the organisations capacity, which supports people living in poverty in Leeds.	5000
Happy Wanderers Ambulance Organisation	Funding for mini bus repairs, fuel, insurance and repair work to ensure the charity transport service (free service) is ready to respond to the future needs of older and disabled people, post Covid, in the Harrogate community area.	1000
Lifeline Harrogate	Funding for core running costs to provide move-on accommodation for vulnerable adults transitioning from homelessness. The funding will ensure that the quality of accommodation and support can be maintained to the highest professional standard.	5000
Igbo Union Yorkshire, CIC	Funding for volunteer, activity and premises costs. The activities take place in Leeds Council Community Hall that provides support for BAME groups.	5000
ROKT Foundation	Funding for staff & premises/utilities cost of running a 6 month programme which would use climbing and urban adventure activities to promote positive mental health amongst young people in Calderdale/Huddersfield. The CIO operate within a climbing & activity centre and have history of working with public, private and third sector partner to benefit marginalised groups.	5000
Creative Recovery CIO	Funding would cover staff cost to keep running the "Uplift Coffee Cafe Choir" project - a singing support group for older people in Barnsley - for 6 months. The group hope to achieve a step change of sustainability by exploring more fundraising options and expanding their income streams.	5000
Concrete Youth	Funding would cover the following costs - sensory equipment/toys/training, Makaton training, 3x computers, 1x printer, overhead costs (rent, payroll). The Hull based group want to continue to offer a high level of sensory theatre to people with profound multiple learning difficulties.	5000

Kingstrust Network CIO : Gateway Community Care Hub	Funding would contribute towards the installation of a new kitchen and core running costs of the Withernsea Community Care Hub and kitchen for three months. The group intend to provide therapy to local residents 4 days per week through market gardening, teaching allotment vegetable growing skills, and cooking healthy meals.	5000
Little Crickets Pre-school	Funding for staff costs to undertake forest school training to deliver outdoor activities for children. The activities will provide an opportunity for hands on outdoor learning to support children's mental health and wellbeing. Also the funding will cover the cost installing secure fencing to keep area and equipment safe.	5000
Speak With IT	Funding to contribute towards the cost of Speech and Language Therapy Assessments needed to resume face to face SALT assessments for 25x paused clients after a long period of inactivity.	5,000
The Ethel Trust	Funding for running cost of community barge that provides residential canal experience for disadvantaged groups in the community. This activity is to improve the health and wellbeing of community members most affected by the pandemic.	1000
YORK HOSPITAL RADIO	Funding for broadcast licenses to support hospital radio playing to patients 24 hours a day.	1000
Nidderdale & Pateley Bridge Men's Shed C.I.O.	Funding for first aid training, utilities and tools to develop volunteers and create a welcoming and well supplied environment for Shed participants.	5,000
North and West Yorkshire A Supporting Older People CIO	Funding would cover staff cost for a year of a new position. This role would make welfare and befriending calls to members. It would also cover staff cost for a year of an existing project manager role to drive membership and develop the service. The Bradford based charity support people/families who are affected by Spina Bifida and/or Hydrocephalus.	5,000
	Funding for staff costs to pay 3 months salary for Befriending and Activities Manager to develop group activities, conduct volunteer interviews for befriending service and inductions for new volunteers members.	1000
